



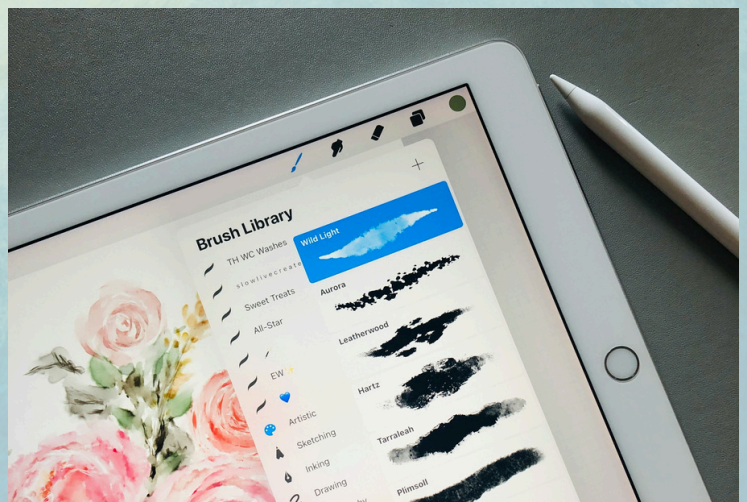

SKETCHING & ILLUSTRATION

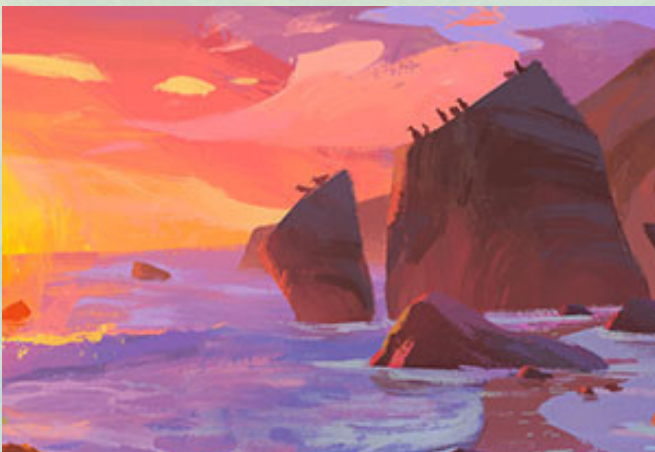
